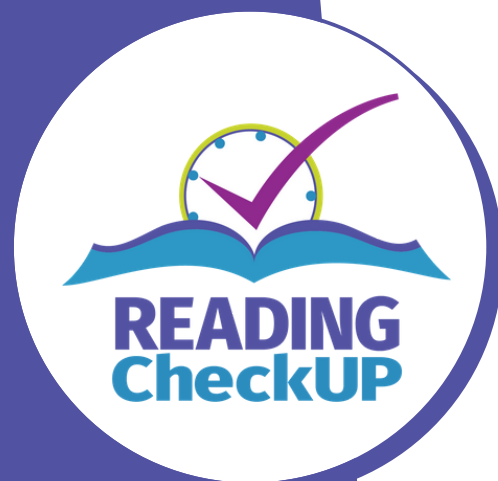
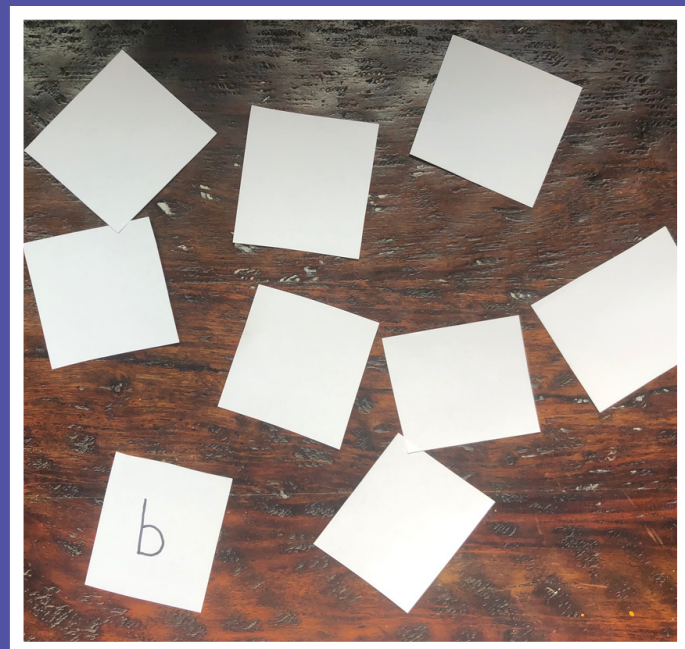


CHILD-MANAGED CODE -FOCUSED

I'M GOING ON A LETTER SOUND TRIP



Time: 15 minutes

Materials:

- Paper
- Pencil
- Crayons or markers

The child needs to quickly recognize a familiar skill used in a new, unfamiliar learning activity.

Write each alphabet letter that the child knows on a piece of paper. Lay the letters face down.

Ask the child to choose a letter card, say the letter name, and its sound. If the child chose the letter b card, for example, ask the child to repeat after you, "I'm going on a trip and I'm taking ...b" (saying the sound, not the letter name). The child either calls out something that begins with that sound, or looks around home for an object that begins with that sound. If the child finds a book, the child then says, "I'm going on a trip and I'm taking a book."
